School Reopening

Dear Parent/Carer,

As always, I hope this letter finds you safe and well.

By now you may have heard some significant news regarding the start of January school reopening. Earlier this evening, the Government announced that secondaries (and primary schools in certain areas) will have a delayed restart next term.

Having watched the briefing, read the guidance and digested the information, it is clear that primary schools in our region will be returning, as planned, on Monday 4th January 2021. I will update you if this changes.

Just to reiterate, we will be open to all our children from Monday 4th January. As mentioned, if this information changes, I will update you as quickly as possible.

The effective procedures and routines, put in place prior to Christmas, remain - as does your child's start and collection time. Your child, and every member of our school and wider community, is my utmost priority — now more than ever. Therefore, we will continue to implement the highest level of hygiene, social distancing and other measures stated in our reopening risk assessment (available on our website).

Can I also please remind you all, to maintain social distancing; not to gather chatting at the front of the school after drop off or collection; and to inform the school as soon as possible if your child or a member of your household is showing symptoms (and therefore is isolating or awaiting test results) or has tested positive, via the google form found on the Newsletter every week or via the e-mail address covid@galleyhillprimary.co.uk
