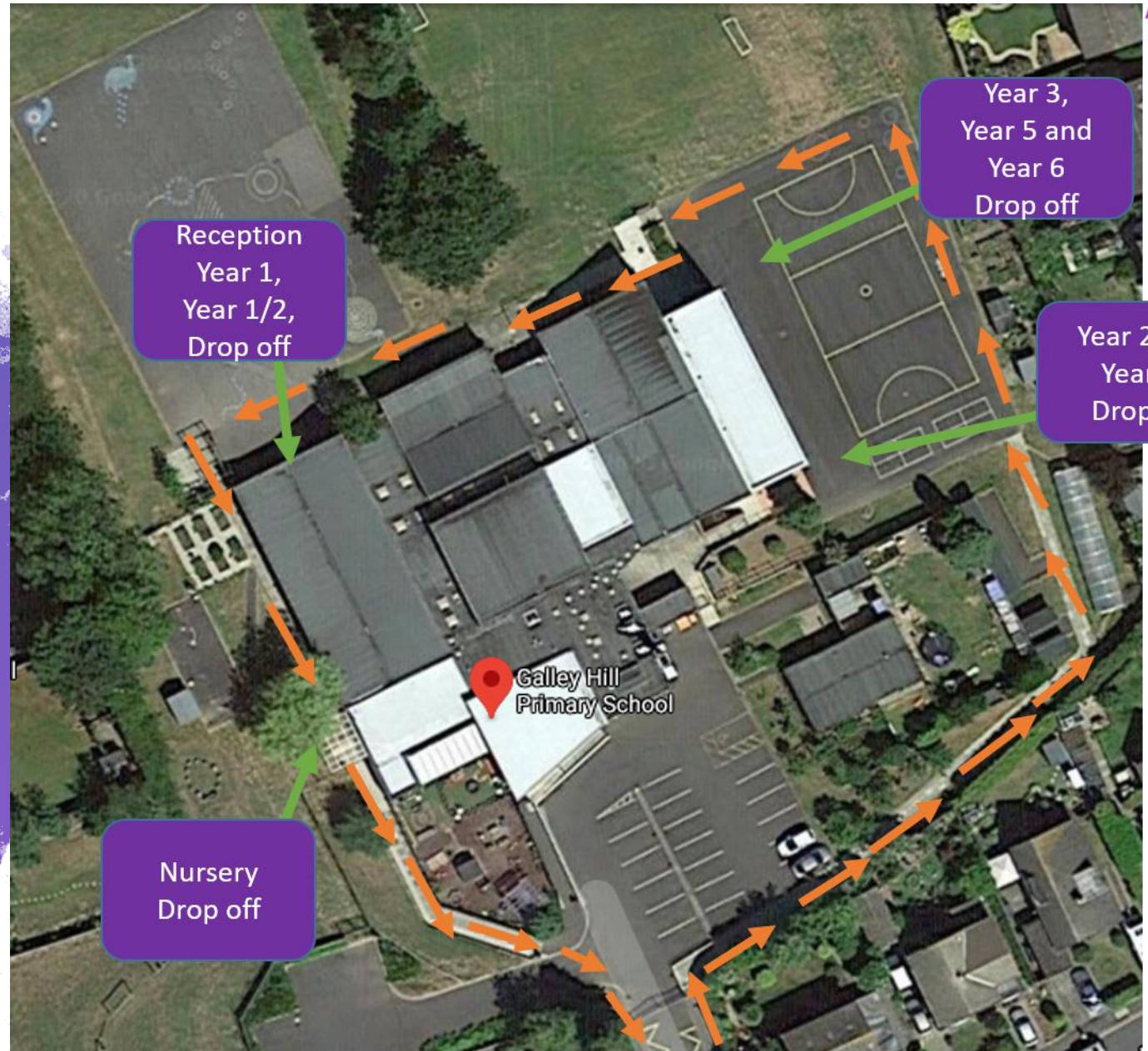
Before you leave your house

- ✓ Wear your school uniform
- ✓ Make sure you have your lunch box (if you are not having a school dinner) and your water bottle. These will stay in your classroom and go home with you everyday.
- ✓ You will not need to bring in a P.E Kit on Wednesday, you will bring it on the days you have PE. Your teacher will let you know when this is when you are in school.
- ✓ Wash your hands before you leave.
- ✓ Where possible, avoid public transport. Give yourself extra time and walk to school.

Arriving at school

- ✓ Each year group will arrive at different times. Please make sure you arrive at the correct time to ensure we
- ✓ You will need to arrive on time and you can not wait with other families
- ✓ You will enter school through the Key Stage 2 gate.
- ✓ Where possible, avoid public transport. Give yourself extra time and walk to school.

Getting back to normal

- ✓ In the first two weeks back, we will all be looking at Here we are by Oliver Jeffers. We will look at values, how we play a big role in our communities and in the world.
- ✓ We will be making sure we know all the new routines in school and what the new timings of the day are
- ✓ We start straight away making sure that we are ready to learn

Entering your classroom

- ✓ As you enter school, you will enter through different entrances. You can see which entrance you will take.
- ✓ You will then be asked to wash your hands.
- ✓ You will place your coat and anything else you have brought in, in the classroom and not the cloakroom like you normally would.
- ✓ Classroom layout is going to be different to the last time you saw them.
- ✓ You will have your own table and all of your equipment will stay on your table.
- ✓ Stay in your seat at all times – put up your hand if you need the teacher
- ✓ If you need the toilet, you can go, but you must ask first and not spend time with other children. You must also wash your hands
- ✓ If you need to cough or sneeze, then remember you must, 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it'.

Catch it, Bin it, Kill it

- ✓ 'Catch it' means you sneeze in a tissue or your elbow
- ✓ 'Bin it' means you put your tissue in the bin as soon as possible
- ✓ 'Kill it' means you wash your hands.
- ✓ There will be tissues and a lidded bin in your classroom so you can safely throw away your tissues.



Breaktimes

- ✓ You will get 2 break times. One in the morning and one in the afternoon.
- ✓ It might not be where you usually play
- ✓ You can only play with children that are in your phase/bubble.
- ✓ There will be some new games that we will help you play.
- ✓ When break time has ended, you will wash your hands on the way back to your classroom.

Lunchtimes

- ✓ You will wash your hands before going for Lunch.
- ✓ You will have your lunch in the hall
- ✓ If you fall over at lunch or break and you need first aid, an adult will help you but they might be wearing some different clothes.
- ✓ You will have a shorter lunch time than usual, but you will have longer break times.
- ✓ When Lunch time has ended, you will wash your hands on the way back to your classroom.

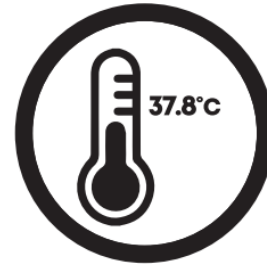

Protecting from germs

- ✓ If you feel unwell or if someone is helping you with first aid, they might be wearing some different clothes to help keep us all safe.
- ✓ Adults might wear a mask, gloves, an apron or even a face mask.
- ✓ Underneath all of this is one of your teachers, and they are still wanting to make sure that you are safe and well. They just look a little different. You might have seen some people with gloves and facemasks on the television or if you have been out.

Leaving school at the end of the day

- ✓ Your teacher will tell you when you are to leave and there will be an adult at the doors to make sure you go home with your adult.
- ✓ When you leave with your adult, you must not mix with other children. Walk straight off the school site on the one way system.

When you get home

- ✓ Wash your hands when you get in
- ✓ Tell everyone at home what you have been doing in school
- ✓ Have a well earned rest and get ready for the next day.
