Implementation → How do we teach our Geography Curriculum?

LESSON STRUCTURE AND
RETRIEVAL PRACTICE

Geography is taught and recorded in geography booklets. Each lesson encompasses a range of geographical skills. Each lesson builds up on the knowledge and skills taught in the previous session. Children are equipped with new weekly geographical vocabulary, which is used in their recording and helps consolidation of learning. The children take part in retrieval practice every session, to enable the children to recall important information taught in previous sessions. Each lesson follows a range of activities such as fieldwork, using maps and atlases and partner talk.
